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## TWO DEGREES, ONE PATH

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### **TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2025-2026**

#### Associate in Arts to Bachelor of Arts in Special Education

##### ***Overview***

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate in Arts (AA) degree at the Gateway Community and Technical College (GCTC) and leads to the Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Special Education degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

##### ***Applying to the Gateway2NKU Program***

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at Gateway CTC, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at Gateway CTC.

##### ***Degree Requirements for GCTC***

1. Completion of minimum 60 credit hours
2. Minimum cumulative GPA 2.0
3. Minimum of 15 credit hours earned at the institution awarding the degree,
4. Demonstration of digital literacy
5. College success requirement

##### ***Admission Requirements to NKU***

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

Undergraduate teacher candidates can apply to the College of Education once they have successfully completed 45 semester hours of required general studies coursework, including having successfully completed EDU 104 and PSY 100 (or an equivalent). Teacher candidates must complete the admission application, submit an FBI background check and create an account with the Kentucky Education Professional Standards Board (EPSB).

Applicants to the College of Education must meet the minimum GPA and entrance exam requirements. Three options are available:

Option 1

- Minimum GPA 2.75 overall (NKU & transfer combined)
- Minimum Exam Scores
  - o ACT Composite of 22; or
  - o Combination of subject exams
    - § Reading: ACT 20 or Praxis 150
    - § English/Writing: ACT 18 or Praxis 158
    - § Mathematics: ACT 19 or Praxis 144

#### Option 2

- Minimum GPA 3.00 overall (NKU & transfer combined)
- Minimum Exam Scores
  - o Combination of subject exams with lower Praxis
    - § Reading: ACT 20 or Praxis 145
    - § English/Writing: ACT 18 or Praxis 153
    - § Mathematics: ACT 19 or Praxis 139

#### Option 3

- Minimum GPA 3.00 in most recent 30 attempted credit hours
- Minimum Exam Scores
  - o ACT Composite 22; or
  - o Combination of subject exams:
    - § Reading: ACT 20 or Praxis 150
    - § English/Writing: ACT 18 or Praxis 158
    - § Mathematics: ACT 19 or Praxis 144

For full admission, teacher candidates must register for remaining Foundations courses not yet completed (EDU 300, EDU 305, EDU 316 or equivalent). Each of these courses must be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher. They must also register for CMST 101 and/or ENG 316 or equivalent. These courses must be completed with a grade of 'B' or higher.

All application requirements must be completed by the deadlines posted, December 1st for Spring admission semester, and August 1st for Fall admission semester.

### ***Degree Requirements for NKU***

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

In addition, students must meet the following requirements for admission into the Teacher Education Program. Courses in parentheses are GCTC course equivalencies.

- 45 earned credit hours
  - o EDU 104 with a grade of C or higher
  - o PSY 100 (PSY 110)
  - o CMST 101 (COM 181) with a grade of B or higher
  - o ENG 102 (ENG 102) with a grade of B or higher
  - o EDU 300 (EDP 202) with a grade of C or higher
  - o EDU 305 (EDU 201) with a grade of C or higher
  - o EDU 316 with a grade of C or higher
- 2.75 or higher overall GPA (all transfer & NKU coursework combined) - OR - 3.00 or higher GPA in your last 30 attempted credit hours
- Meet the entrance exam requirement through an approved combination of passing scores on the ACT and/or Praxis I Core Academic Skills for Educators exams\*

- ACT Comp. 22 -OR-
- Reading (ACT: 20 -or- Praxis I: 150) and
- Eng./Writing (ACT: 18 -or- Praxis I: 158) and
- Mathematics (ACT: 19 -or- Praxis I: 144)
- Successful completion of a recent FBI criminal background check
- Completed Teacher Education Admission Application

\*Minimum Praxis score is five (5) points lower for each subject exam if your overall GPA is 3.00 or higher.

\*Passing ACT scores must be less than ten (10) years old at the date of admission to the teacher education program. Your date of admission occurs at the end of a successful admission semester, not at the beginning.

For the fall Admission Semester, the deadline to meet the above requirements must have them on file with the COE is August 1

For the spring Admission Semester, the deadline to meet the above requirements must have them on file with the COE is December 1

Registration for EDS 360, EDU 313 and Admission Field Experience (EDU 303, 307, 309, 311 or 334) may only be completed after all above requirements are met. Seats in the admission courses are limited. Therefore, to ensure the best course selection get your requirements completed early! Work with your COE advisor to ensure proper enrollment

### ***General Transfer Information***

Students must complete the online application to NKU. There is no application fee for students who are transferring from GCTC.

**KCTCS Scholars Award:** Students who are KY residents transferring directly from a KCTCS institution with at least 36 hours from that institution and minimum GPA of 3.0, were never enrolled as a degree-seeking student at NKU, and will be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours both fall and spring semester are eligible for a limited number of annual scholarships (fall and spring only). Students must gain admission to NKU by June 15 for fall and November 1 for spring to be eligible for a possible scholarship. Online accelerated programs are not eligible for the KCTCS Scholars Award.
